



# Queens Chess Club Championship Round 6



## Welcome to the 2011 Queens Chess Club Championship !!

The time control is game in 2 hours (120 minutes). If you are using an analog clock, please set it for 4:00 for the time to run out at 6:00. If you are using a time delay clock, set the delay for five minutes and the time to count down from 1 hour 55 minutes, depending on which kind of clock you have. A delay clock is preferred. Please arrange yourselves so that the clock faces the center aisle.

We are using duplicate score sheets so that we can provide weekly bulletins. Please submit a copy to Brian Lawson or leave them on the basement stage when you mark the pairing sheet. In some cases we need both player's copies to figure out the moves so each player should submit a copy, preferably simultaneously.

When your game is over, please mark your result on the pairing sheet, turn in your copies of the score sheet and do not analyze or talk while there are still games going on. You are permitted to quietly watch the other games. If you have a friend or relative still playing, please stand behind that player, **not** facing him or her.

The Championship will run from October 7 to November 25, 7-SS, G/120, up to three ½ point byes permitted with advance notice (Rounds 5-7 must commit before Round 4 (November 4); no round on October 28 due to unavailability of site.

Guaranteed prizes to top 3: \$500-\$300-\$200 and 30 grand prix points; large class prizes as entries permit (2007 tournament had U2200 prize of \$190). Registration 7:30-8:00, round at 8:15 each Friday. Boards and a few sets provided, bring clocks.

This tournament is being FIDE-rated.
